

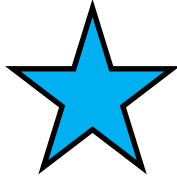

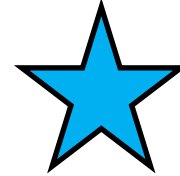

Physical Damages

Businesses and Private Nonprofits (PNP):

- Real Estate or Leasehold Improvements
- Machinery and Equipment
- Furniture and Fixtures
- Other Business Assets

Interest rate as low as 4% for businesses and 2.625% for PNPs

Up to \$2 million

Economic Injury

It is not necessary to have physical damages for the Economic Injury Disaster Loan

Small Businesses and Private Nonprofits:

- Accounts Payable
- Normal Rental Expenditures
- Monthly Fixed Debts and Expenses
- Other Working Capital Needs

Interest rate as low as 4% for businesses and 2.625% for PNPs

Up to \$2 million

Homeowners

- Real Estate of Residence

Interest rate as low as 1.688%

Up to \$200,000 for Primary Residence

Terms up to 30 years

Renters and Homeowners

- Personal Property (Including Automobiles)

Interest rate as low as 1.688%

Up to \$40,000

You may apply before insurance is settled or proceeds are received.
