MECU was recognized for helping hundreds of organizations throughout the city to celebrate their neighborhoods through the MECU Neighborhoods Events Grants program. PNC Bank was acknowledged for its "Growing Up Great" initiative, which supports enrichment programs to prepare children from birth to age 5 for success in school and life.
