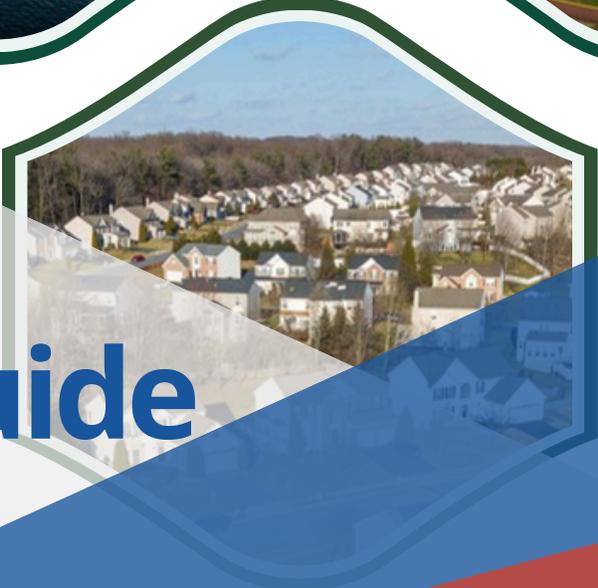

ALLY

\$7,500+

Reflects organizations with a larger operating footprint in the region.

Examples: regional anchors, development and investment firms, university/health system divisions.

3

CATALYST

\$10,000+

For established organizations positioned to help accelerate progress on the region's most pressing priorities. Catalysts play an active role in shaping GBC's strategic initiatives—convening peers, informing policy, and championing collaboration across sectors.

Examples: major professional services firms, philanthropy, mid-sized corporates, institutional divisions, regional development organizations, and industry associations.



NOTE: The Chairman’s Circle, Visionary, and Champion partnership investment tiers do not include event sponsorship recognition. Event sponsorship is a separate opportunity.

Advanced visibility through GBC communications (with approval) and nomination for a Board seat.

Examples: large employers with 1,000+ regional employees, regional HQs, and major development firms.

CHAMPION (EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE ELIGIBLE)

\$50,000+

Shapes regional priorities between Board meetings.

Examples: major corporate and institutional anchors, financial institutions, universities, and health systems.

4

VISIONARY

\$75,000+

Premier regional positioning and year-round visibility. Deep partnership with GBC leadership.

Examples: national or global corporations whose brand elevates the regional narrative.

5

CHAIRMAN’S CIRCLE (ALL BENEFITS INCLUDED) **\$100,000+**

Reserved for organizations whose scale drives generational impact across the region.

Examples: largest regional employers, global institutions headquartered here, firms leading transformational projects.

Each committee is co-chaired by two key members of GBC Board or Strategic Partner organizations and meets quarterly, working closely with GBC's management team to guide implementation, share insights, and ensure that the business community's leadership is both visible and effective.

GBC's Steering Committees serve as the primary platform for partner engagement — bringing together leaders across sectors to advance the region's priorities. Together, GBC's Board and Steering Committees form an integrated leadership network that drives execution of our Multi-Year Agenda.

ADVANCING INFRASTRUCTURE COMMITTEE

Champions major federal, state, and local investments in infrastructure assets and systems — from broadband and clean energy to ports and roads — that support economic growth and improve quality of life in the region.
